



Social process by which people are treated differently and disadvantageously, under similar circumstances, on the basis of gender. Everyone is affected by gender inequality - women, men, trans and gender diverse people, children and families.

What is gender equality?


Gender equality is when people of all genders have equal rights, responsibilities and opportunities.

- 27.2% percentage of women on companies' Board of Directors
- 14% percentage of firms which have a female top manager
- 36% percentage of firms with women in senior roles
- It will take 257 years to reach worldwide economic gender equality
- Women make up 24% of the world's parliamentarians and 5% of its mayors
- On average, women are paid 24% less than men for comparable work, across all regions and sectors
- 153 countries have laws which discriminate against women economically, including 18 countries where husbands can legally prevent their wives from working
- Worldwide, 1 in 3 women and girls will experience violence or abuse in their lifetime


